

1 What is Super5-4-3-2-1 and Super5-4-3-2-1 PLUS

Super5-4-3-2-1 is a fixed odds game which is played using a field of numbers from one (1) to forty-five (45). Super5-4-3-2-1 uses the Super5 main draw as the basis for prize fulfilment.

Super5-4-3-2-1 PLUS is a fixed odds second chance add-on game to the Super5-4-3-2-1 game which is played with the original set of numbers selected by the player for the Super5-4-3-2-1 game. Super5-4-3-2-1 PLUS uses the Super5 PLUS draw as the basis for prize fulfilment. The Super5 PLUS draw is a second draw from a pool of numbers from one (1) to forty-five (45) that is extracted following the main Super5 draw.


Both Super5-4-3-2-1 and Super5-4-3-2-1 PLUS offer the same four (4) basic playing options:

- Match 1 one (1) number is chosen
- Match 2 two (2) numbers are chosen
- Match 3 three (3) numbers are chosen
- Match 4 four (4) numbers are chosen

Playing Super5-4-3-2-1 PLUS option gives you the possibility of winning; in the main Super5 draw, the Super5 PLUS draw or BOTH draws if your selected numbers are drawn in both draws.

2 Playslip Description

The Super5-4-3-2-1 playslip is used by the players before purchasing a Super5-4-3-2-1 ticket to indicate their selection of numbers and playing options (e.g. game type, price, multiplier and number of consecutive draws, etc.). The following illustration demonstrates how a Super5-4-3-2-1 playslip is filled in:



3 Super5-4-3-2-1 Ticket Description

The ticket is the unique valid document for claiming winning prizes. The following is an illustration that represents a visual of the Super 5-4-3-2-1 ticket, including the information displayed on the ticket.

- Game logo
- Draw date in which the ticket is participating
- Validity of the ticket, including draw number
- Barcode number
- Playing Board(s) including: Numbers chosen, Game type, Stake, Quick Pick if selected, Number of Combinations.
- Super5-4-3-2-1 PLUS participation (Yes/No)
- Multiplier value
- Price of the ticket
- Ticket number
- Date and Time of purchase
- Barcode and Retailer ID

It is the player's entire responsibility to ensure that the selections printed on the ticket are correct and in line with the ones selected.

The player has the possibility to cancel a ticket from an authorised agent, up to 10 minutes after the purchase but not later than the stipulated cancel close time.

4 How Super 5-4-3-2-1 and Super 5-4-3-2-1 PLUS are Played

4.1 Simple Columns

To play a Simple Column in Super5-4-3-2-1, the player should mark one (1) to four (4) numbers (with an 'X') according to the Game Type selected, in at least one (1) of the eight (8) Playing Boards of the playslip.

The game types available are:

- **Match 1** where a player chooses one (1) number and marks the box [1] in the game type area. A bet is placed on any number of the five (5) numbers drawn.
- **Match 2** where a player chooses two (2) numbers and marks the box [2] in the game type area. A bet is placed on any two (2) numbers of the five (5) numbers drawn.
- **Match 3** where a player chooses three (3) numbers and marks the box [3] in the game type area. A bet is placed on any three (3) numbers of the five (5) numbers drawn.
- **Match 4** where a player chooses four (4) numbers and marks the box [4] in the game type area. A bet is placed on any four (4) numbers of the five (5) numbers drawn.

The player is allowed to play only one game type option per Simple Column.

To participate in the Super5-4-3-2-1 PLUS draw, the player should indicate so, either when playing through the playslip, verbally over the counter, online, or by repeating an already played ticket with the 'play-it again' feature. The same set of numbers chosen to participate in the first Super5 draw, are also valid for the second draw, Super5 PLUS.

4.2 Systems

A Fully Expanded System entry is an alternative way of playing Super5-4-3-2-1, providing the player with more chances to win.

A System entry allows the player to select more than the minimum amount of numbers but not more than twenty (20) in a single Playing Board, for each game type.

- **Match 1 –** a player may choose more than one (1) number
- Match 2 a player may choose more than two (2) numbers
- Match 3 a player may choose more than three (3) numbers
- Match 4 a player may choose more than four (4) numbers

The four tables on the following page show the columns created in each system of Match 1, Match 2, Match 3, and Match 4, with the respective cost for each column.

The minimum stake for all four game types is €1.00. Playing the Super5-4-3-2-1 PLUS option doubles the stake.

4.3 Full Quick Pick

Full Quick Pick is a fully automatic number selection method whereby the terminal generates all of the numbers, according to the game rules. The player should mark the Quick Pick box on any one of the eight (8) boards, together with the preferred game type. The player should also mark the basic stake.

4.4 Partial Quick Pick

Partial Quick Pick is a semi-automatic number selection method, whereby the system generates numbers complementary to the numbers selected by the player or authorised agent. If the player chooses only some of the numbers in the Numbers Area on one board, the rest of the numbers for the same board are quick picked by the system.

4.5 Different Playing Methods on One Playslip

The terminal allows the player to include different playing methods on one playslip. For example, on the same playslip, the player can play a Simple Column in the first Board, Systems in the second Board and a Quick Pick in the other Boards.

4.6 Cancellation of Playing Board

The player is allowed to cancel one or more of the filled in Boards on the playslip by marking the [VOID] box of the relevant Numbers Area.

4.7 Shares

Shares offer the possibility to a group of players to take advantage of, and participate with more numbers and combinations, thus giving the players more chances to win. This is made possible by splitting the Super5-4-3-2-1 and Super5-4-3-2-1 PLUS ticket into 8 to 100 shares. The price of the total Super5-4-3-2-1 ticket is split equally between the number of players.

All players pay their shared Super5-4-3-2-1 ticket separately and get their own share of the Super5-4-3-2-1 ticket receipt. For example, if a €40 ticket is split into ten (10) parts for ten (10) players, the price of each part is €4, whereby each player pays for their share of the participation.

The minimum price of the share is $\in 4$ and the maximum price is $\in 32$.

The maximum price of the whole shared ticket shall be €5,000.

5 Super5-4-3-2-1 Draws

5.1 When can Super5-4-3-2-1 be played

Players can play Super5-4-3-2-1 from Monday to Sunday during the allowed playing hours, excluding the draw break. The Super5 and Super5 PLUS draws, which are used as the basis for prize fulfilment for the Super5-4-3-2-1 and Super5-4-3-2-1 PLUS respectively, are held every Wednesday and Friday.

The draws are broadcasted live on TV with the live stream and recorded draws also available on the National Lottery website. Last participation time is 30 mins before the draw time.

5.2 How the Draw is conducted

The Super5 and Super5 PLUS draws are held in the presence of:

- i. A representative of the Authority
- ii. A Notary Public

The Notary Public, who will be present at the draw, will draw up and sign a record of the proceedings which are entered in a register kept for that purpose.

5.3 Consecutive Draws

The player is given the choice to participate with the same playslip in more than one draw by marking a relative box/es in the 'CONSECUTIVE DRAWS' section.

The player has the possibility to increase the frequency of participation by two (2) up to ten (10) draws, by marking the respective box from two (2) to ten (10) within the 'CONSECUTIVE DRAWS' section. Additionally, the player may further increase the selected number of participation draws by marking the [x2] and/or [x3] box/es. The player can participate up to a maximum of 60 consecutive draws.

Example: If a player selects the boxes [7] and [x3] in the 'CONSECUTIVE DRAWS' section, his playslip will participate in 21 Consecutive draws.

5.4 Super5-4-3-2-1 Liability Limits

Super5-4-3-2-1 will support a draw liability limit which shall be configured to a pre-defined amount. Once the liability limit has been reached, National Lottery plc. shall reject any subsequent attempts to place Super5-4-3-2-1 bets on the specific combination(s), that would cause the draw liability to exceed the limit.

6 Cost of Entry in Super5-4-3-2-1

The Stake amounts of €1.00, €2.00, €3.00 and €5.00 are included in the stake are on the Super5-4-3-2-1 playslip. The player should mark with an 'X' on the preferred basic stake to participate with in a selected Game Type, as shown in Examples Section 8 below. Playing the Super5-4-3-2-1 PLUS option doubles the stake.

6.1 Multiplier

In the 'MULTIPLIER' section, the player has the option to multiply the basic stake by marking the box with the selected multiplier.

By marking the respective box within the 'MULTIPLIER' section from two [2] up to ten [10], the player has the possibility to multiply the stake by two (2) up to ten (10) times. For example, if the player selects the multiplier [6], the stake will be multiplied by six (6) times.

By additionally marking the boxes [x5] and/or [x10], together with one more multiplier box from two [2] up to ten [10], the player has the possibility to further multiply the stake by up to five hundred (500) times (i.e. if the three boxes [10], [x5] and [x10] are marked).

Note: The 'MULTIPLIER' box marked will multiply the total stake for all the Playing Boards filled on the playslip.

7 Super5-4-3-2-1 and Super5-4-3-2-1 PLUS Prizes

To win in Super5-4-3-2-1 and/or Super5-4-3-2-1 PLUS, the player must match the selected numbers with the drawn numbers. The more numbers the player plays, the greater the winning probabilities.

Following is a table showing the corresponding winning amounts and odds for each Game Type:



Match 4	Any four (4) numbers out of five (5) numbers drawn	€15,000 x the stake	1:29,799

Playing Super5-4-3-2-1 PLUS option gives you the possibility of winning; in the main Super5 draw, the second Super5 PLUS draw or BOTH draws if your selected numbers are drawn in both draws.
















